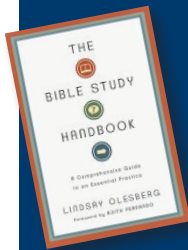

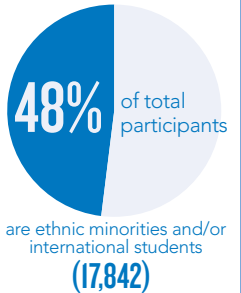


Proxe Stations are innovative interactive evangelistic art displays created by staff and 2100 Productions for use during outreach events.

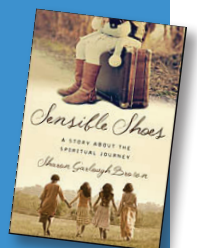



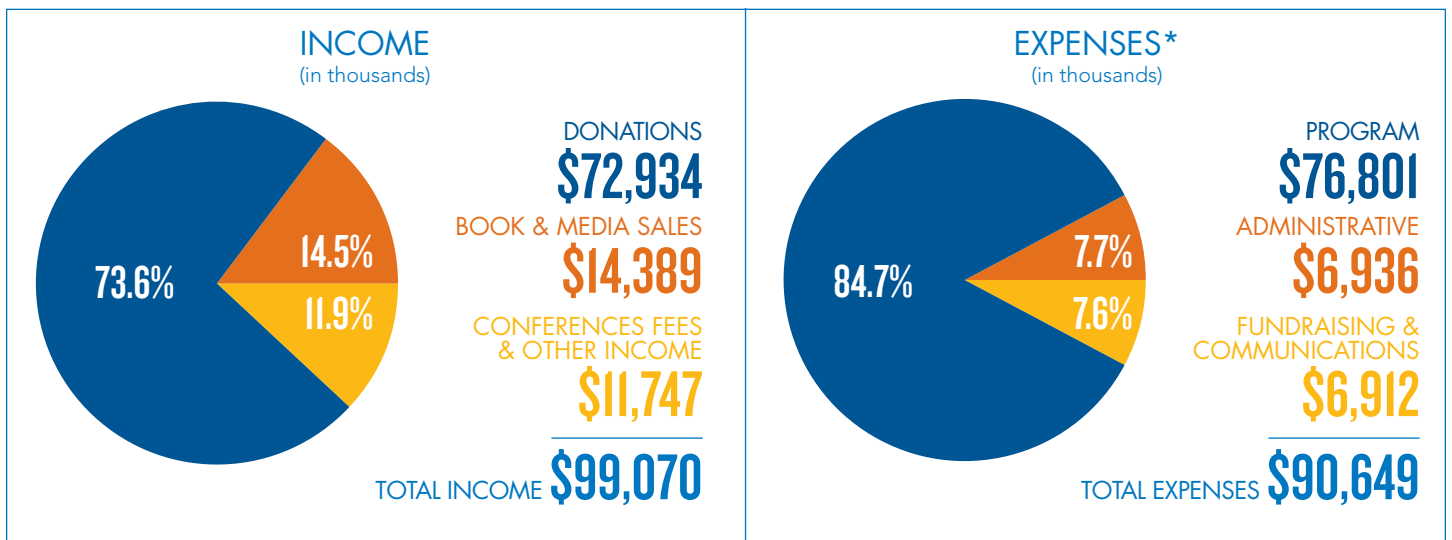
